GENERAL APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- ❑ A signed, personal letter from applicant explaining your career goals and qualifications to receive the scholarship.
- ❑ **Two** letters of recommendation.
- ❑ Official high school or unofficial college transcripts **OR** copy of high school diploma or GED certificate (whichever is most applicable).
- ❑ Copy of Lamar Community College Notice of Admissions (if Fall 2012 will be your first semester at LCC).
- ❑ Copy of GED certificate (if applicable).

Daniels Opportunity Scholarships

Available to:	Adult students (age 22 and older) who demonstrate financial need according to FAFSA for Fall 2012 semester. Priority will be given to those who have earned their GEDs rather than a high school diploma. Additional consideration may be given to foster care youth, juvenile justice youth, and returning military personnel. Scholarships are also open to students completing Emergency Medical Technician coursework.

For those individuals who have been through the juvenile justice system, at least one of the letters of recommendation should come from the Chief Probation Officer or his designee from the applicant's Judicial District Probation Department. May be renewable for a second semester, dependent on student's gpa. Previous recipients must provide updated cover letter and unofficial transcript from completed semester(s) when reapplying.
