PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Scholarship Description:

The Lamar Community College Foundation invites qualified seniors to make application for its 2010-11 Lamar Community College Presidential Scholarship. The scholarship is available to graduating seniors from Colorado. Seventy-five percent (75%) of the scholarships are reserved for graduating seniors from southeast Colorado school districts that are members of the Southeast Colorado BOCES or located in LCC's primary service area. Applicants are required to have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0. (Preference will be given to applicants having a high school GPA above the minimum 3.0 requirement.) The scholarship funds up to the equivalent of 15 credits per semester of tuition and fees for two-years/four semesters/60 credit hours. The recipient must maintain full-time student status and a cumulative 3.0 grade point average. Summer semester attendance and course-specific fees are not covered by the scholarship. (The estimated value of a two-year/four-semester scholarship is \$6,080). Valedictorians selected as recipients of an LCC Presidential Scholarship will be awarded a book scholarship of \$400 per semester. (The estimated value of a two-year/four-semester LCC Presidential Scholarship for a valedictorian is \$7,680.) Receipt of need-based aid may affect final award amount.

All applicants are required to complete the attached application information form, provide a high school transcript with cumulative GPA, and attach a copy of the applicant's notice of admissions to LCC. Applicants must also provide a college transcript (if applicable), attach a copy of ACT or SAT score, provide two letters of recommendation and a letter of application addressing the applicant's career goals and high school activities. Students who are awarded a Presidential Scholarships are expected to contribute 10 hours per semester of service to the Foundation.

Minimum Eligibility Criteria Requirements for Applicant Are:

- student currently enrolled in a Colorado High School or enrolled in an approved home school curriculum,
- candidate for spring semester 2010 graduation,
- cumulative high school GPA of at least 3.0. (*Preference will be given to students having high school GPA's higher than 3.0.*), and
- officially admitted to Lamar Community College.

The Selection Committee will consider only applications that Include:

- a completed, dated and signed scholarship application form,
- a copy of the Lamar Community College notice of admissions,
- a signed letter of application addressing educational/career goals and high school activities,
- a copy of high school transcript with cumulative GPA,
- a copy of ACT or SAT score,
- a copy of each college transcript with cumulative GPA (dual credit students must submit transcript from college where enrolled),
- two letters of recommendation from student's current high school teachers, counselors, or principal (other than family members) addressing school-related leadership activities,
- for home school students: evidence of approved home school curriculum.

Deadline to Submit Materials:

The selection committee will consider only complete application packets that are on file with the LCC President's Office by 3:30 p.m., Monday, March 1, 2010.

Selection Process:

The LCC Presidential Scholarship Selection Committee will select student scholars to interview for the 2010-2011 LCC Presidential Scholarship during March. Finalists for the LCC Presidential Scholarship will be invited to interview with the selection committee. Please note that the number of scholarships awarded is determined by the Foundation's resources. Students are expected to accept or decline the Presidential Scholarship within two weeks of being selected.

Renewal:

The LCC Presidential Scholarship will be renewed for the 2011-2012 academic year if the applicant meets the following criteria:

- recipient has maintained full-time student status (full-time status is defined as completing 12 or more credit hours for each fall and spring semester),
- recipient has a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 upon the first anniversary of the recipient's high school graduation for all LCC courses taken after graduation from high school,
- recipient has completed a renewal request form by June 1, 2011.
- recipient has contributed 10 hours of service per semester to the Foundation.

Discontinuance of a LCC Presidential Scholarship will occur when:

- the scholarship recipient's duration of enrollment reaches the second anniversary of his/her high school graduation,
- recipient's GPA falls below the required cumulative 3.0 GPA, and/or
- recipient has fulfilled requirements for a degree or certificate.
- recipient has not contributed 10 hours of service per semester to the Foundation.
