COLLEGE ANNOUNCES RESTRUCTURING

(Lamar, Colorado; July 8, 2008) Since arriving on campus on June 1, President John T. Marrin has given extensive thought to the organizational structure that would best serve the current and future needs of the College within its existing budget constraints. In considering his options, he was impressed at the current staff and faculty's strengths. President Marrin has announced the following changes to the College's administrative structure.

Vice President of Student Services - Chad DeBono

Most recently Dean of Administrative Services, DeBono will move to Vice President of Student Services. Chad previously served in Recruiting, Activities, and Student Government within Student Services. He will supervise Adult Transition and Learning Support Services, Student Services, Athletics, Residence Halls, and International Programs.

Vice President of Academic Services - Del Chase

After leading LCC's successful Agriculture and Equine programs, Chase will assume the position of Vice President of Academic Services. With over 20 years in teaching experience, Del will be responsible for enhancement and growth in both academic and vocational programs on the LCC campus and beyond. As the chief academic officer for the College he will also ensure the academic integrity of LCC's offerings.

Vice President of Administrative Services - Cheryl Sanchez

Two Buttes native and former successful Springfield business owner, Sanchez quickly made an impression on the college as Small Business Development Center coordinator and Business instructor, then as Associate Dean of Academic Services. Her extensive business experience and attention to detail will serve her well in the administrative division. Sanchez will supervise Facilities, the IT Network, Business Office functions, as well as the College's Campus Bookstore.

Executive Dean of Academic Services - Dan Minor

Minor will assume the position of Executive Dean of Academic Services after serving in several roles at the College. He also served as Small Business Development Center coordinator, moving to Dean of Applied Programs, then to Dean of Academic Services.

Dean of Student Services - Angela Woodward

Woodward has been serving as Associate Dean/Director of Student Services for two years. Prior to that time she was the College's Director of Admissions. She is directly responsible for daily operations of the Student Services Center and its personnel as well as other areas within the

Student Services division. Woodward has served within various capacities in Student Services for 15 years.

The new configuration allows for a flat structure, similar to one designed and recommended by the LCC Deans' Council recently.
