



## Associate Degree Nursing Program

The process of admission to the nursing program is a separate process from admission to Lamar Community College.

### **Prerequisite Courses Required: *Must be completed prior to application to the Nursing Program***

- Accuplacer Score of EA 61 or above or documentation of completion (C or above) of equivalent math course. (MAT 090 or above)
- ENG 121 English Composition,
- PSY 235 Human Growth and Development
- BIO 201 Anatomy and Physiology I (with lab)
- BIO 202 Anatomy Physiology II (with lab)
- BIO 204 Microbiology (with lab) (Requires prereq of BIO 111)
- LPN License (for students entering into the second year of the program who are not continuing directly from the first year)

### **Upon completion of Prerequisite Coursework:**

- Send a copy of your transcript(s) to verify required 2.5 GPA to:

Admission will be offered once application and transcripts are received, and student will be provided the list of additional criteria that must be met, which will include the PAX-RN Entrance Exam.

### **Co-requisite Courses:** Must be completed before you can enter the second year of the nursing program:

- BIO 216 Human Pathophysiology
- 3 credit hours of Social & Behavioral Sciences or Humanities  
(See LCC catalog for a list of acceptable courses)

**NOTE: All of the above courses must be completed with a G.P.A. of 2.5 or above  
All BIO prefixed courses must have been completed within 7 years prior to entry into the Nursing program.**

**Licensed Practical Nurses and students who have not been continuously enrolled from the first to the second year of a nursing program, wishing to enter the R.N. year of the program may be required to complete NUR 189 *Transition from LPN to ADN***

Nursing students have the option of sitting for the PN NCLEX after successful completion of the first year of the program. They may then sit for the RN NCLEX upon successful completion of both years of the program.
