

College Opportunity Fund

If you are classified as in-state for tuition purposes, your first stop on campus should be to register for the College Opportunity Fund. You are entitled to an \$62 stipend per credit. Register now at <http://cof.college-assist.org> or on campus before Census Day. See LCC's Student Services Center for details.

Advising

As you progress through your academic career, and especially as you construct a degree plan and register for courses, you'll be working with an academic advisor. You've been assigned an advisor, in most cases based upon your expressed academic interests. It's important that you establish a good working relationship. Take advantage of this person's expertise to assist you in making the important decisions that lie ahead. Your advisor is there to provide guidance, now and throughout your academic career. *Individual academic advisors' hours may vary; consult daytime hours posted on office doors. Advisors are also available at 9:30a-6p on Wed, 8/18; 1-5p on Thurs, 8/19; 9a-1p on Fri, 8/20; 9a-1p on Sat, 8/21; and 8a-6 p on Mon, 8/23.* See LCC's Student Service Center for locations.

Assessment

Lamar Community College believes that students should have information about their level of basic academic skills. In compliance with

Colorado State Statutes (C.R.S. 23-1-113.3) the college requires that new students demonstrate their basic skill proficiencies. First-time students who enroll in a degree program (Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, Associate of General Studies, or Associate of Applied Science) must be assessed in mathematics, writing, and reading. Any other students who seek to enroll in college-level English or Math courses are also subject to this assessment requirement. *You may take basic skills assessments without an appointment. See orientation insert for lab hours and locations. Allow two hours for testing. Please see our staff in Bowman 129.*
