Description:

The Lamar Community College Foundation invites qualified graduating seniors to apply for 2015-16 Lamar Community College Presidential Scholarships. The scholarship is available to graduating seniors from Colorado and residents of Colorado. Seventy-five percent (75%) of the scholarships are reserved for graduating seniors from southeast Colorado school districts that are members of the Southeast Colorado BOCES or located in LCC's primary service area. Applicants are required to have a minimum 3.25 unweighted high school grade point average (GPA) or higher. The scholarship funds up to \$2,000 per year. The recipient must maintain full-time student status (12 credit hours per semester) and a cumulative 3.0 grade point average. (The estimated value of the two-year/four-semester scholarship is \$4,000). Although this is a merit-based scholarship receipt of need-based aid may affect final award amount.

Application packet requirements:

1. Completed application; dated and signed (electronic signature will be accepted)
2. Colorado high school transcript with cumulative *unweighted* GPA
3. Colorado college transcript (if applicable) cumulative GPA, (concurrent enrollment/ASCENT students must submit transcript from college where enrolled)
4. Copy of ACT or SAT score
5. Two (2) letters of recommendation from student's current high school teachers, counselors, or principal
6. Letter of application addressing the applicant's educational, career goals and high school activities
7. For home school students: evidence of approved home school curriculum

Presidential Scholarships requires 10 hours of service to include:

- State Board for Community Colleges & Occupational Education Annual Tour
- LCC Foundation Antelope Classic Golf Tournament

Completed application packets:

- Must be received in the LCC President's Office by 3:30 p.m., Thursday, March 12, 2015
- May be sent via email to paula.dieterle@lamarcc.edu

Interviews with the LCC Foundation Presidential Scholarship Committee:

- Will be conducted by WebEx or in person within two weeks of deadline
- The number of scholarships awarded is determined by the Foundation's resources
- Recipients must accept or decline the Presidential Scholarship within two weeks of notification

Renewal for 2016-2017:

- Recipient has maintained full-time student status (full-time status is defined as completing 12 or more credit hours for each fall and spring semester),
- Upon the first anniversary of the recipient's high school graduation, recipient has a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 for all LCC courses taken after graduation from high school,
- Recipient has completed a renewal request form (sent by LCC President's office) by June 4, 2015.
- Recipient has contributed 10 hours of service per semester to the Foundation.

Discontinuance:

- The scholarship recipient's duration of enrollment reaches the second anniversary of his/her high

school graduation,

- Recipient's GPA falls below the required cumulative 3.00 GPA, and/or
- Recipient has not contributed 10 hours of service per semester to the Foundation
- Recipient has fulfilled requirements for a degree or certificate
